Roger E. “Pops” Lewis, 72, of Clinton, passed away, Wednesday, February 5, 2014 at the University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics – Iowa City, Iowa

Burial will be in the Clinton Lawn Cemetery with military honors being conducted by the Clinton AMVETS Post #28. 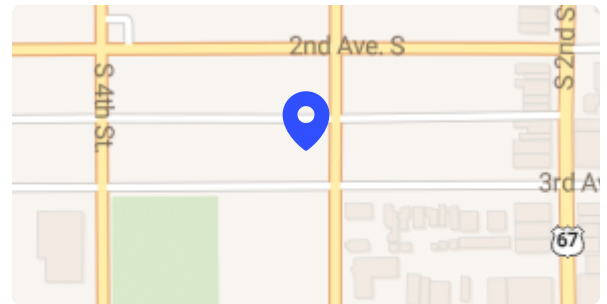

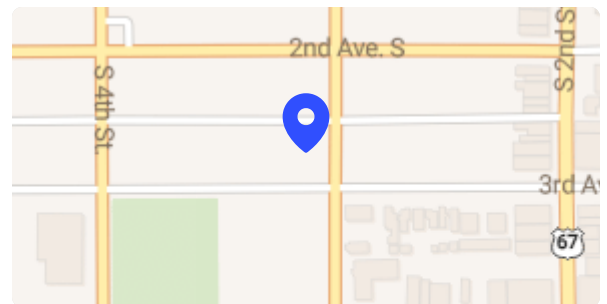

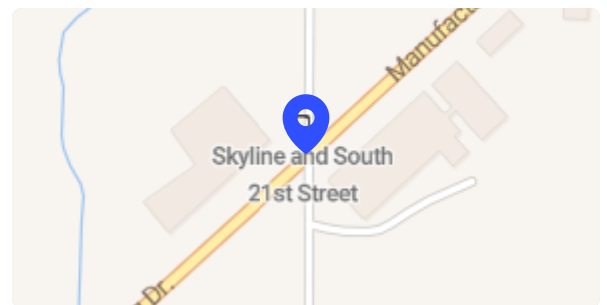
