**J**ohn William Dolan, 90, of Clinton, Iowa, passed away Saturday, March 28, 2015 at his home.

A Funeral Mass will be at held 10:30 AM, Wednesday, April 1, 2015 at Prince of Peace Catholic Church, Clinton. Visitation will be held from 5 PM to 7:30 PM, Tuesday, March 31, 2015 at the Clinton Chapel Snell-Zornig Funeral Home & Crematory. Burial will be in St. Mary's Cemetery. 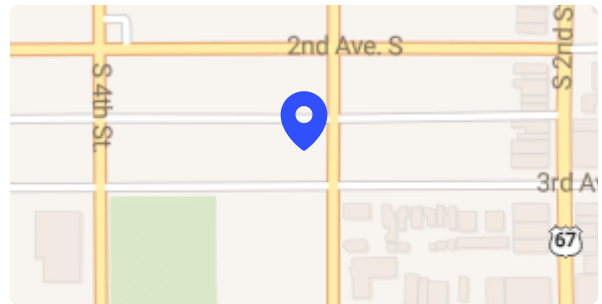

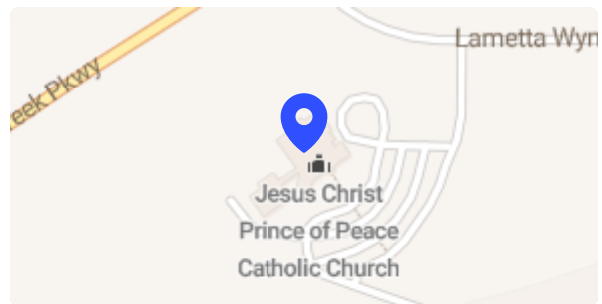

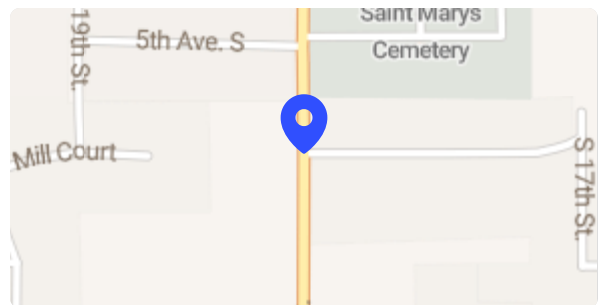
