**B**rian P. Callahan, 63, of Clinton, unexpectedly passed away, Sunday, April 26, 2015 at Methodist Metropolitan Hospital in San Antonio, Texas.

Brian was preceded in death by his parents. Memorials can be made to the family.

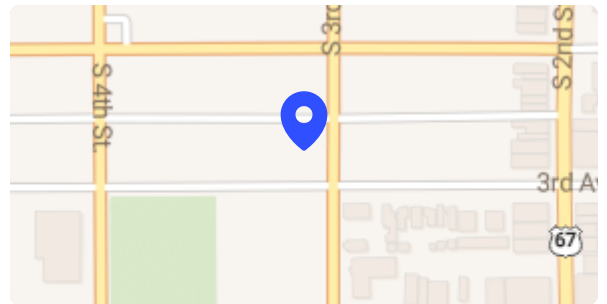

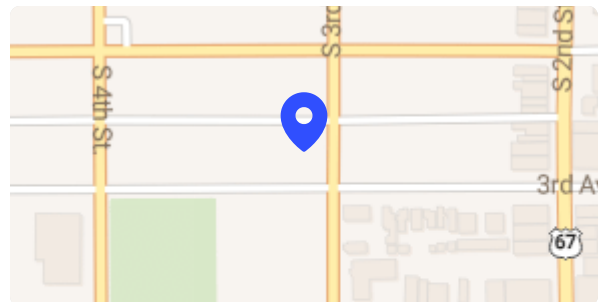

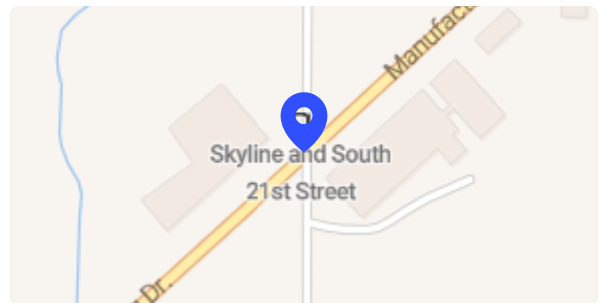
