In lieu of flowers, memorials may be made in Richards name to Coats for Kids.

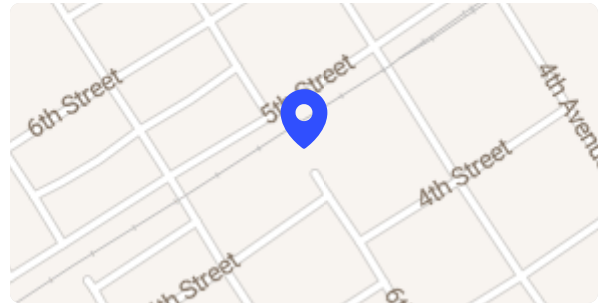
