**F**lorence F. Miller Struck, 92, of Clinton, passed away, Tuesday, November 10, 2015 in her home at Prairie Hills in Clinton.

Funeral Services will be 11:30am, Saturday, November 14, 2015 at the First Baptist Church, 2020 North 3rd St.in Clinton. Burial will be in Clinton Lawn Cemetery. Serving as pallbearers will be her grandsons. Honorary pallbearers will be her granddaughters. Florence worked as a bookkeeper/receptionist at Clinton County Senior Citizen's Office for 4 years, at Clinton Quality Homes and Bossen and Totten for many years. She worked for Dr. Rogers a number of years and also at City Hall in the City Planner's Office. She was a member of the First Congregational Church for 50 years and in later years a member of the First Baptist Church in Clinton. She was a member of the Clintones, the 55 Alive Club, and the AMVETS Auxiliary. Florence was a past president and secretary at the Eagle's Club. She loved to walk, sing, dance, play cards, sit out in the sun, also liked eating ice cream daily at Prairie Hills. In lieu of flowers memorials may be made to the First Baptist Church or The Victory Center.

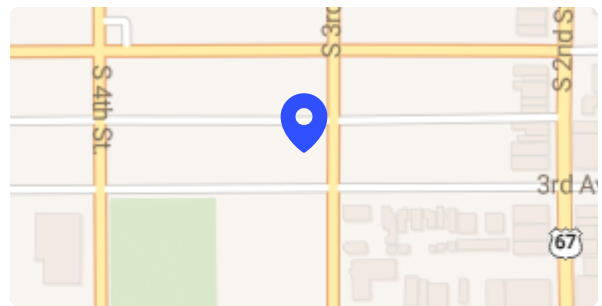

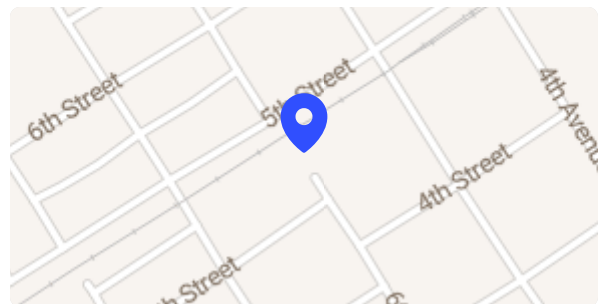

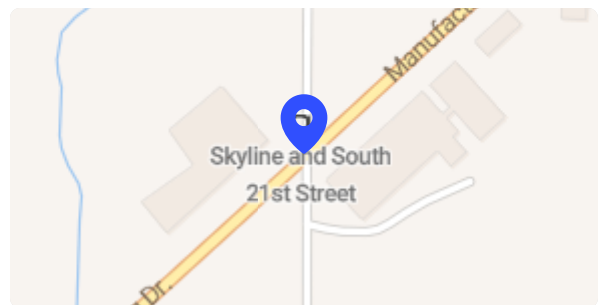
