**D**ouglas M. Bennett, 78, of Clinton passed away, Wednesday, December 9, 2015 at The Villages Rehabilitation Facility in Lady Lake, Florida.

Funeral Services will be 11:00 am Saturday December 19, 2015 at the St. Marks United Methodist Church in Camanche. Burial will be in the Clinton Lawn Cemetery. 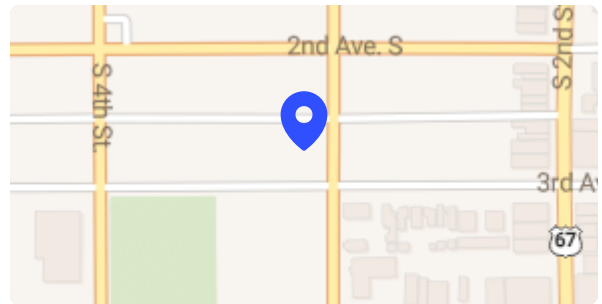

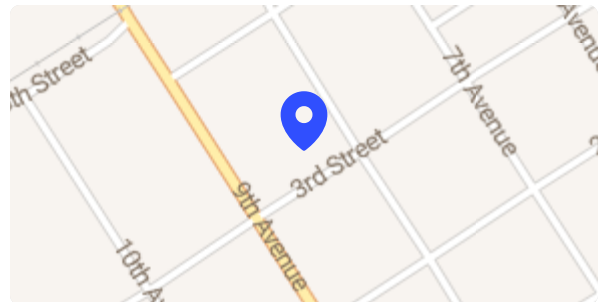

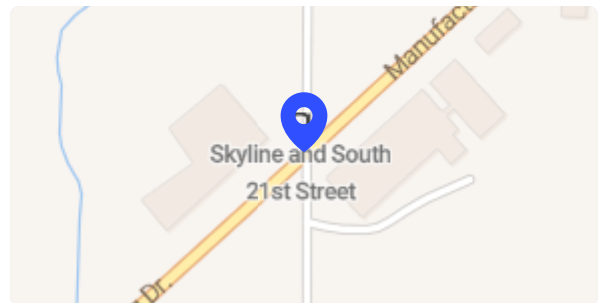
