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James F. Powers, 68, of Clinton, passed away, Saturday, July 23, 2016 at his home in Clinton.

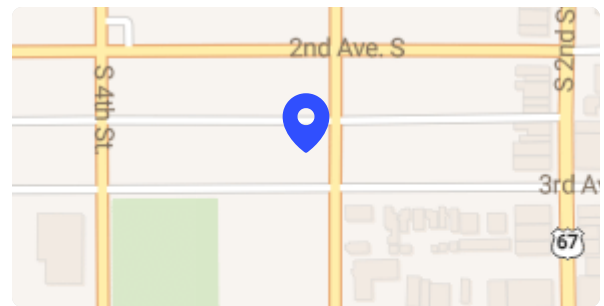

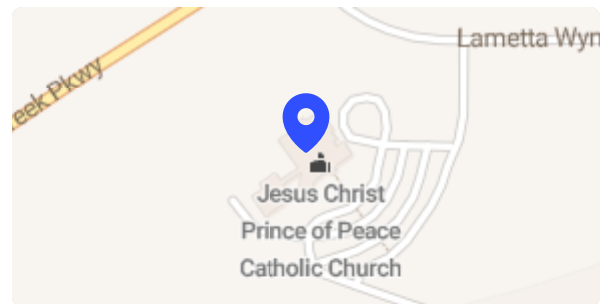
