Judith "Judy" A. Paasch, 71, of Camanche passed away, Thursday, December 15, 2016 at the University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics – Iowa City.

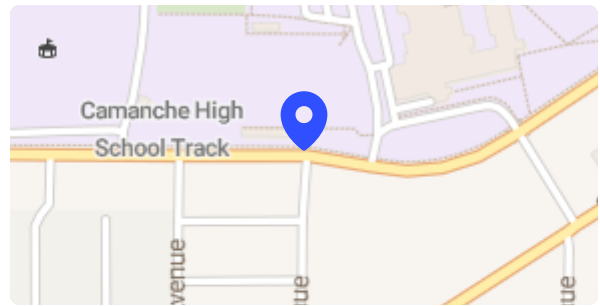

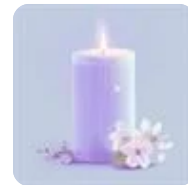
