Raymond L. Moore, 74 of Clinton, Iowa, died Saturday, December 31, 2016 at the Clarissa C. Cook Hospice House, Bettendorf. His body has been donated to the University of Iowa Hospitals and Clinics.

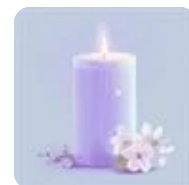

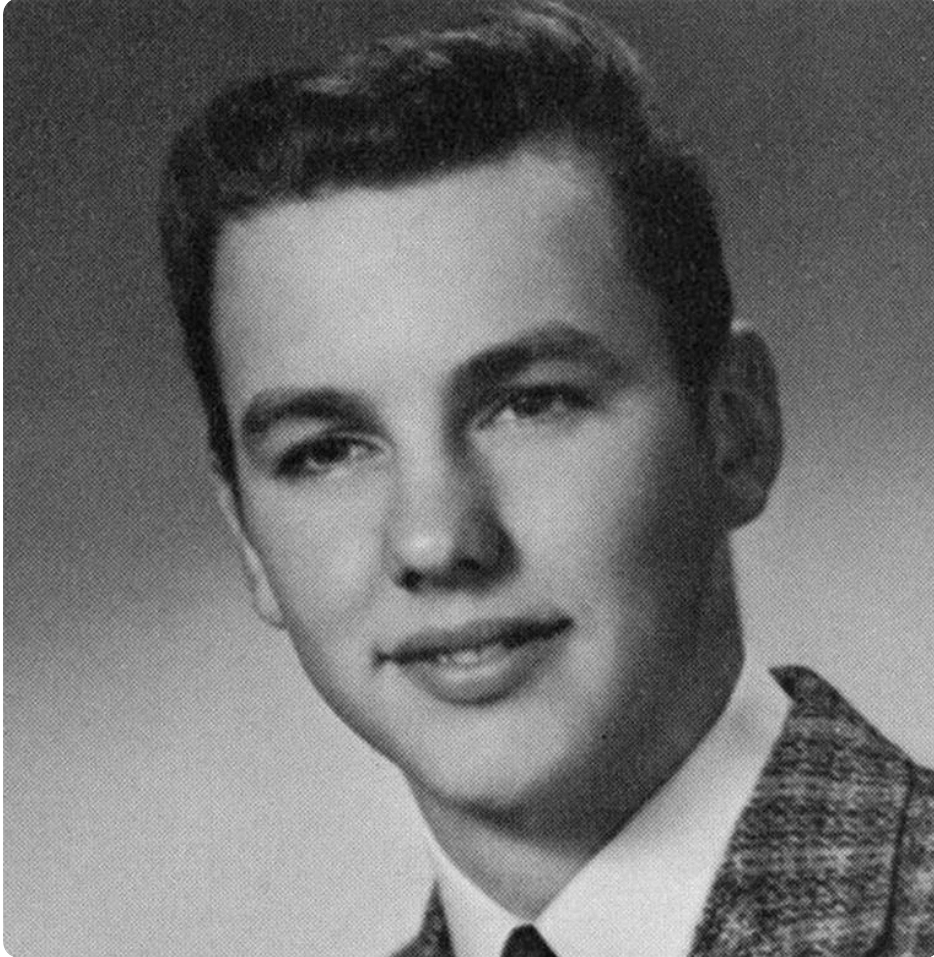
