Larry J. Aude, 71, of DeWitt, passed away, Wednesday, April 12, 2017 at Westwing Place – DeWitt.

Funeral Services will be 11:00 am, Friday, April 28, 2017 at Zion Lutheran Church – Clinton. Burial will be in the Clinton Lawn Cemetery. Larry John Aude was born September 8, 1945 in Clinton, Iowa, the son of Kermit J. and Ida B. (Jacobson) Aude. He was a 1963 graduate of Clinton High School. He served in the United States Army from 1968 – 1970 and was in Vietnam from 1969-1970. He married Carolyn Sukut on June 5, 1971 in Clinton.

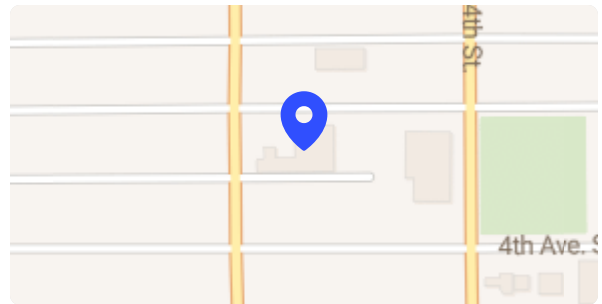

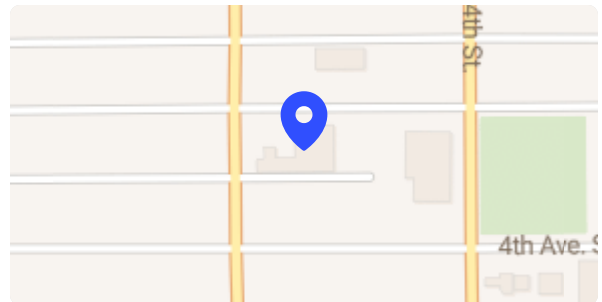

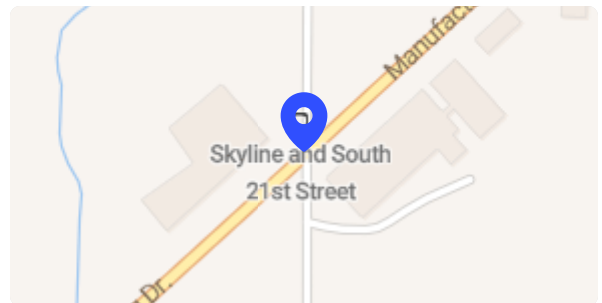
