Memorial may be made to the family.

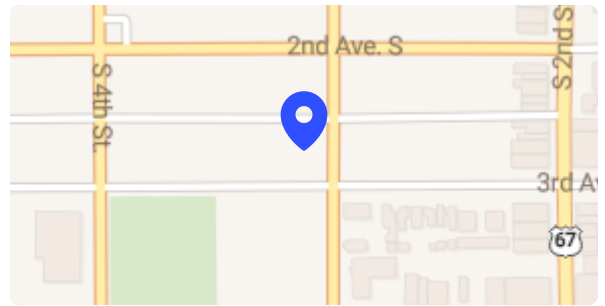

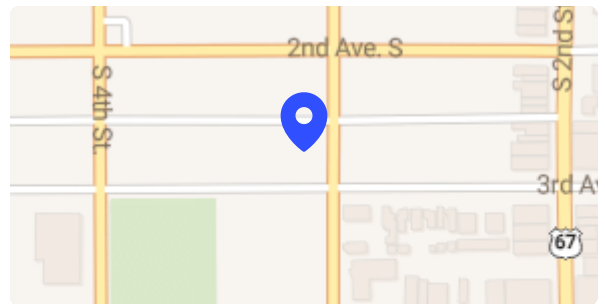
