Ruby E. Schubert, 91, of Clinton, Iowa, died peacefully Saturday, November 18, 2017 at the Clarissa C. Cook Hospice House in Bettendorf, Iowa. Honoring her wishes, there will be a private service at a later date.

Ruby was born on September 23, 1926 to John and Rosene (Horst) Wall in Sabula, Iowa. She graduated from Sabula High School in 1943. She then attended Iowa State Teachers College and Marycrest College. She was an elementary school teacher at Elvira and Sabula. She was the first librarian at the Sabula Public Library. She was married to Earl Holman from 1946 until his death in 1970. She married Paul Schubert in 1977 and relocated to Clearwater, Florida for many years. They moved to Clinton prior to his death in 2006. She was an active volunteer with the Mercy Hospital Auxiliary and a Mercy Hospice volunteer for many years.
