Memorials may be made the family.

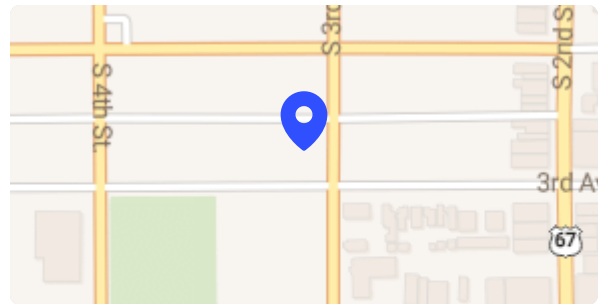

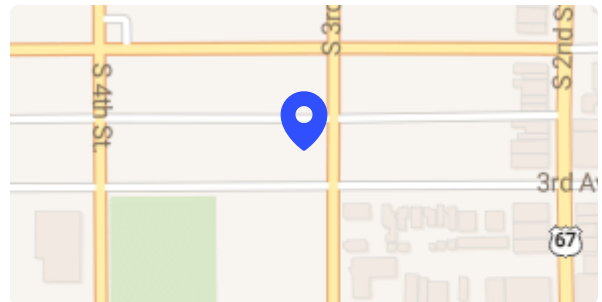

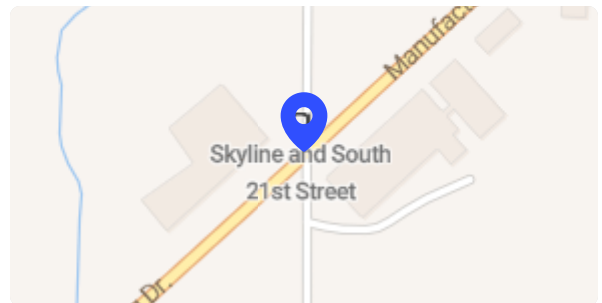
