**D**avid Cozzens, 69, of Clinton, passed away, Wednesday, March 14, 2018 at his home.

After being honorably discharged from the Navy he attended and graduated from Scott Community College receiving a associates degree in engineering in 1973.

He was employed at French & Hecht in Davenport from 1974-1979, and later with Custom Pak as a design engineer from 1979 until retiring in April 2014. 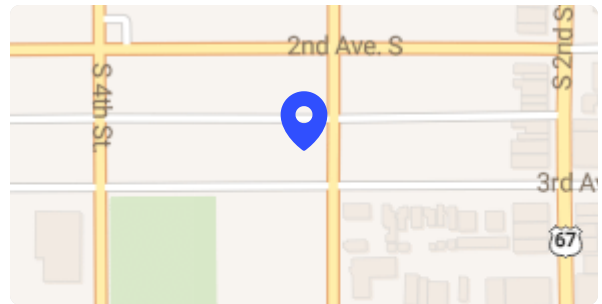

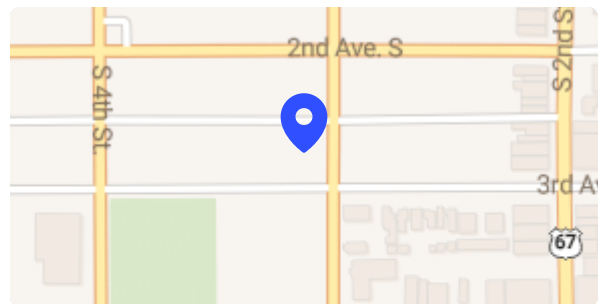

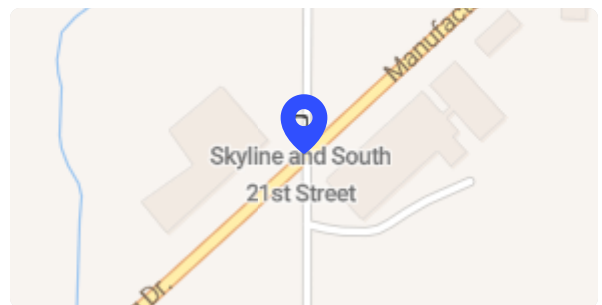
