Memorials can be made to the Clinton Humane Society or the First United Methodist Church.



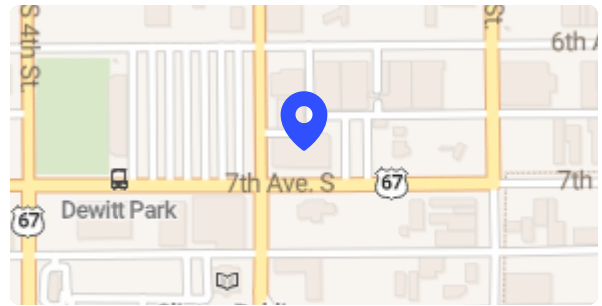

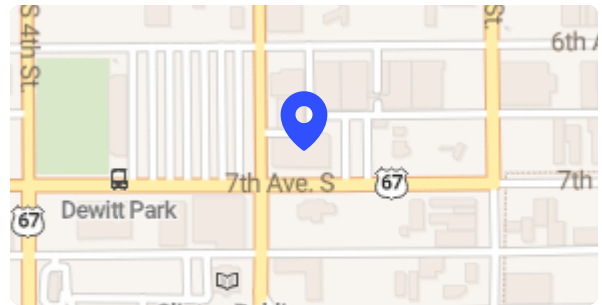
