He seemed to have a real knack for salesmanship, selling magazine subscriptions, pots and pans to eventually siding. He stepped out on his own in business in 1953, which launched United Roofing and Siding with only \$100 in his pocket. He was blessed with success as he built his business and raised a family of five. He married the love of his life, June in 1950, they were married 67 years.

Throughout his life he enjoyed hunting, fishing, was an avid boater and enjoyed Lake Tenkiller in Oklahoma and his Florida home in Gulf Breeze. He loved to garden and share his bountiful produce with many. He loved dancing and his many travels with June. He had a wonderful opportunity this past fall to attend the Quad City Honor Flight to Washington D.C. which was a highlight of his life. His biggest joy in life was spending time with his children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren; they were his pride and joy. Lee had a very winsome personality and was a kind gentleman to all he met. He had a most generous spirit always ready to give a helping hand to those in need and those he loved.

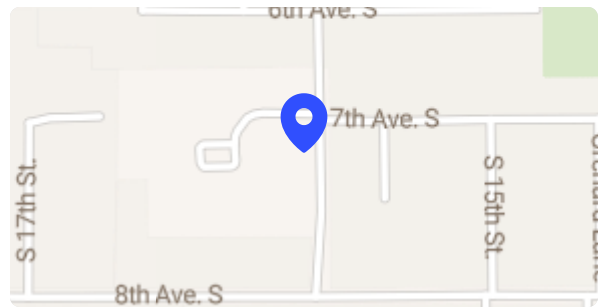

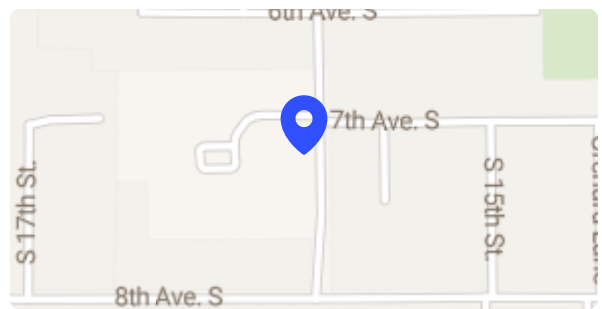
