**F**red A. Weideman, Jr., 87, of Clinton passed away Saturday, June 30, 2018 at his home - Clinton.

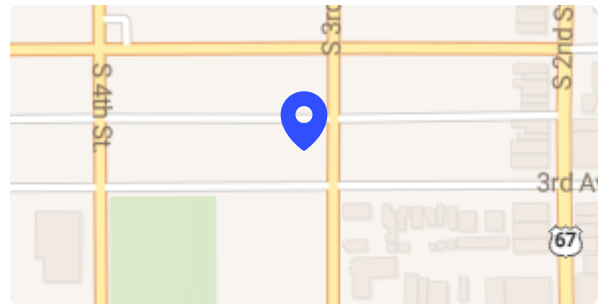

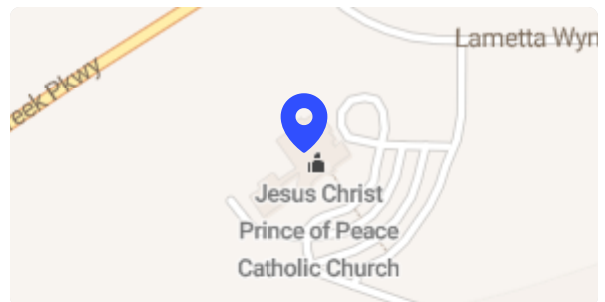

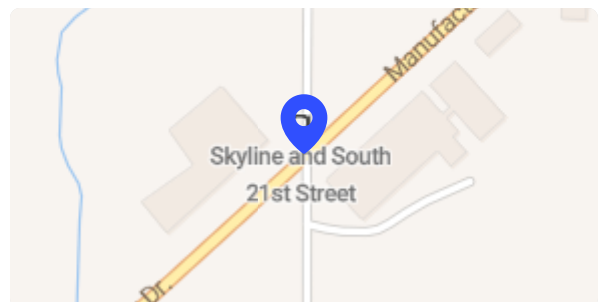
