Annie Lee Mason, 78 of Clinton went home to be with her Savior after a short fight with cancer Saturday, August 25, 2018 at Mercy Living Center – North. Funeral Services will be 11:00 am, Thursday, August 30, 2018 at Church of the Open Door – Clinton. Burial will take place privately at Evergreen Cemetery Hanover on Thursday. Visitation will be from 5:00 to 7:00 pm Wednesday evening at the church. 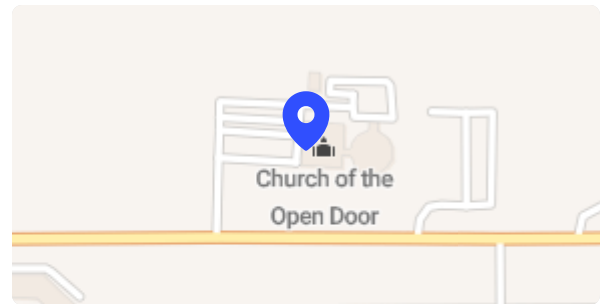

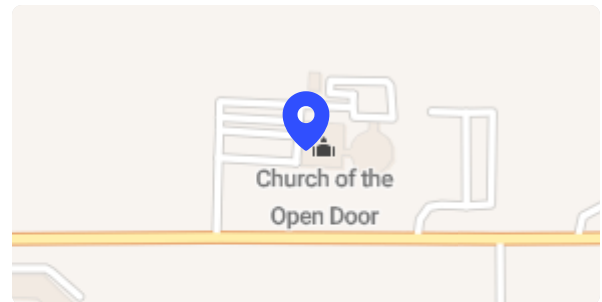
