Audrey L. Vance, 90, of Clinton, passed away, Wednesday, November 14, 2018 at Mercy Medical Center – North.

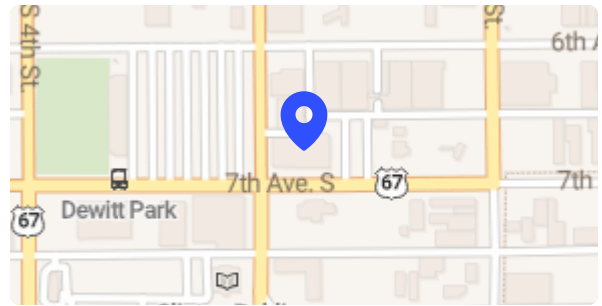

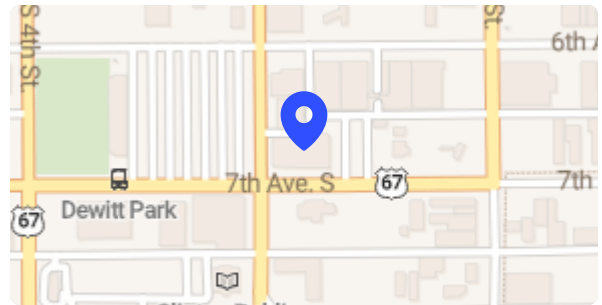
