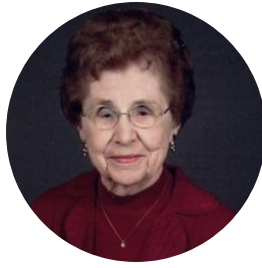

Alice B. Gardner, 92, of Clinton passed away Thursday, December 20, 2018 at her home – Clinton.

Funeral Services will be 11:00 am, Friday, December 28, 2018 at Trinity Lutheran Church – Clinton. Burial will be in the Clinton Lawn Cemetery. Serving as pallbearers will be Matt Zipse, Ryan Torres, Jeff Janka, Bernd Hoefler and Bob Butterworth. Honorary pallbearer will be Bill Venema. Visitation will be from 9:30 am until the service at the church.

Alice B. Boehne was born December 11, 1926, the daughter of Louis F. and Laura (Plath) Boehne in Fairmont, Minnesota. On September 14, 1947 she was united in marriage to William “Bill” R. Gardner in Wilbert, Minnesota; he preceded her in death on December 9, 1990. They lived in Sherburn, Minnesota and in 1961 moved to Savanna, Illinois. In 1968 they moved to Clinton, Iowa.

Alice was a member of Trinity Lutheran Church. For over 40 years she belonged to both Eventide and Altar Guilds. She was a past member of the board of directors for the Clinton Lumberkings and member of the Clinton Country Club. She was the past secretary and treasurer for Mercy Hospital Bridge-a-rama.

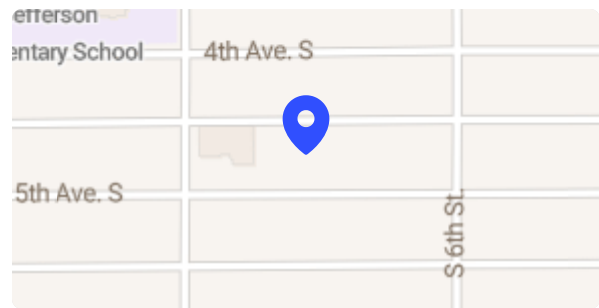

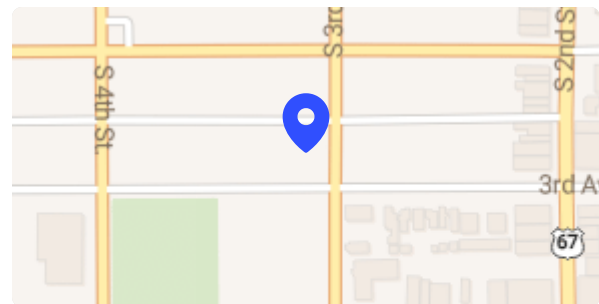

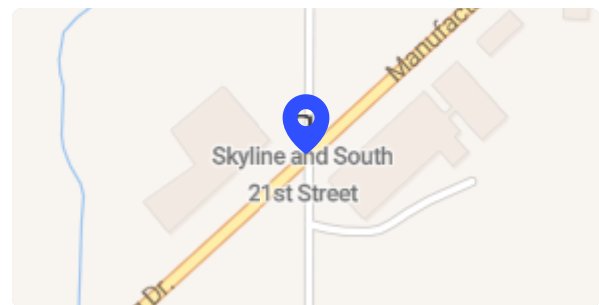
