Joseph O. Eicher, 97, of Camanche, Iowa, passed away Saturday , December 29, 2018 at his daughter's home in Camanche. Services will be held at 11 AM Saturday, January 5, 2019 at the Camanche Chapel Snell-Zornig Funeral Home & Crematory. Visitation will be from 10AM until the service hour at the funeral home. 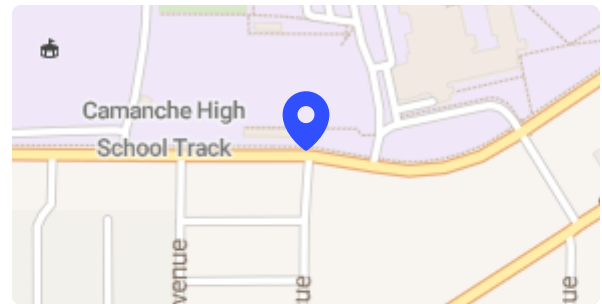

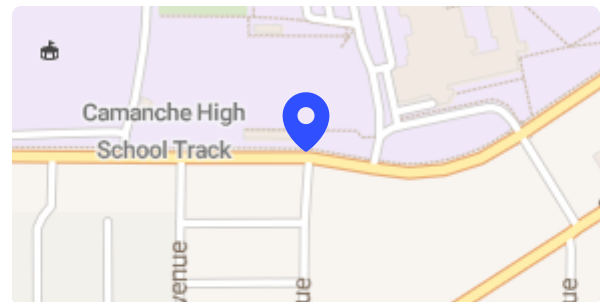

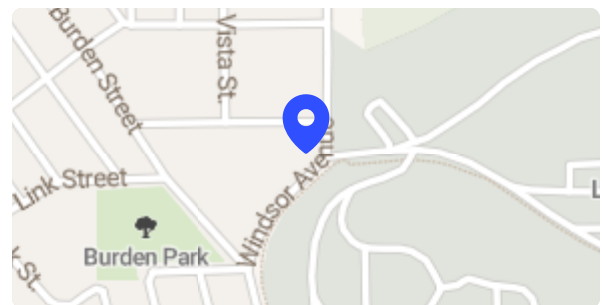
