Memorials can be made to St. Jude's Children's Hospital.

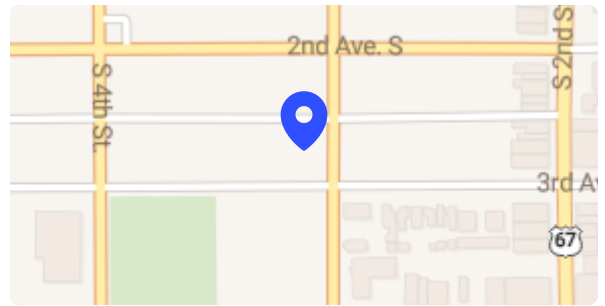

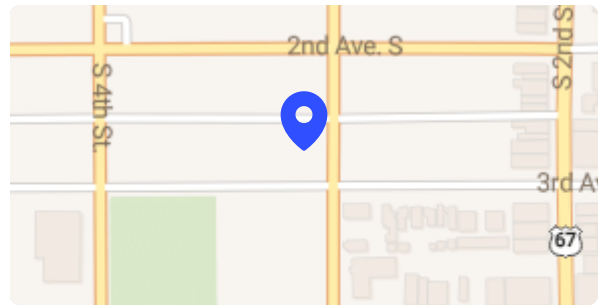
