Holly A. Youngquist, 56, of Clinton passed away Sunday, May 26, 2019 at her home – Clinton.

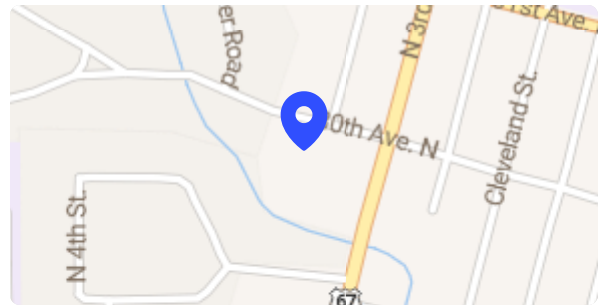
