Virginia M. Blint, 96 of Camanche formerly of Ft. Madison, Iowa, passed away Tuesday, June 11, 2019 at the Alverno Health Care Facility – Clinton.

Two Funeral Masses will take place for Virginia. The first will be 11:00 am Friday, June 21, 2019 at the Church of the Visitation in Camanche. Visitation will be for 1 hour prior to mass beginning at the church. Secondly there will be a Funeral Mass at 11:00 am, Monday June 24, 2019 at St. Mary's Parish in Ft. Madison, Iowa with visitation 1 hour prior to mass beginning at the church. Burial will be in Soldier's Circle in Oakland Cemetery - Ft. Madison, Iowa.

Virginia Mercedes Laughlin was born September 17, 1922 in Ft. Madison, Iowa, the daughter of Cleo and Adelaide (Herold) Laughlin. She graduated from Catholic Central High School in Ft. Madison.
