George Patrick Phillips was born on October 17, 1946 in Clinton, Iowa, the son of George M. and Neva (Wisman) Phillips. He was a graduate of St. Mary's High School in 1965, and then attended Clinton Community College. 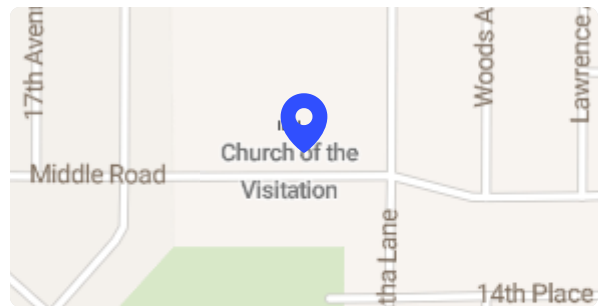

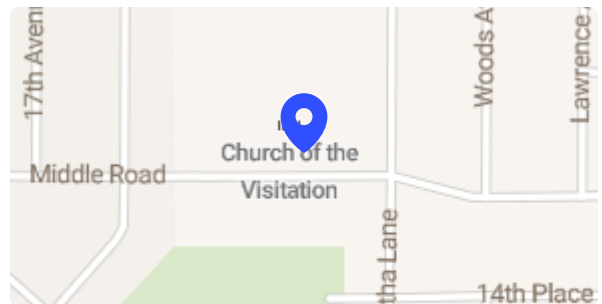

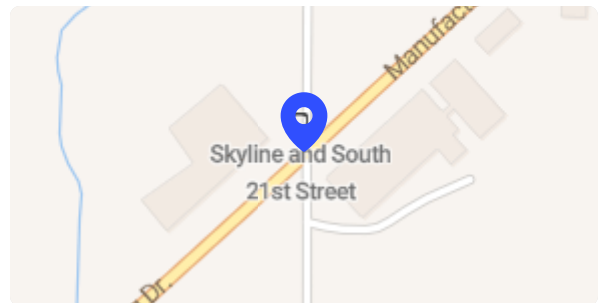
