Sherry L. Emerson, 81, of Camanche, passed away, Thursday, January 9, 2020 at Eagle Point Health Care Center.

Funeral Services will be 11:00am, Monday, January 13, 2020, at the St. Mark's United Methodist Church – Camanche. Visitation will be from 9:00am to the service time at the church on Monday. Serving as pallbearers will be her grandchildren. Private Family burial will be on Tuesday at Rose Hill Cemetery.
