She was preceded in death by her husband, her parents, one brother and one sister. Memorials may be made to the Salvation Army.




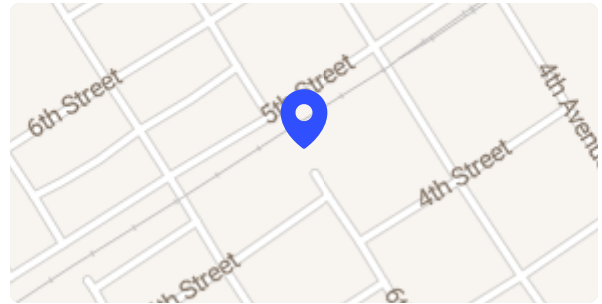
