In lieu of flowers memorials can be made to the family.



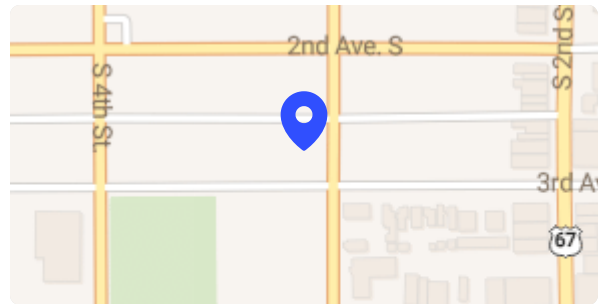

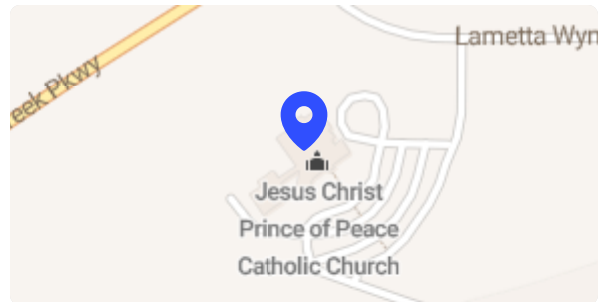

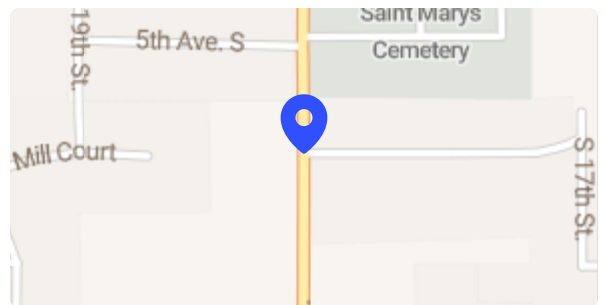
