Shirley J. Garrett, 87, passed away Monday, July 13, 2020 at her home in Camanche, Iowa.

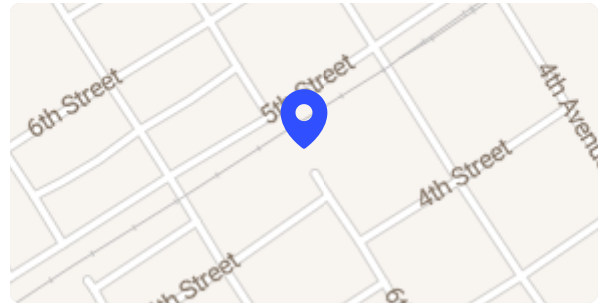

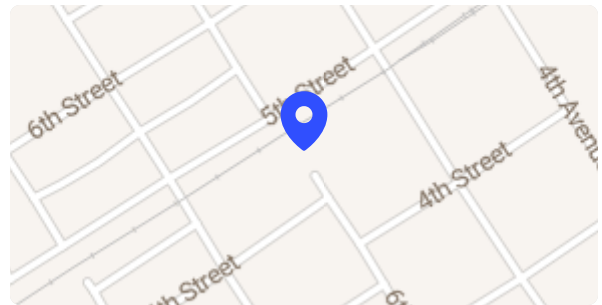
