**J**ames Wisor, 79, of Camanche, Iowa, passed away Sunday, September 13, surrounded by loved ones at his residence.

Jim was born January 20, 1941 in Clinton, Iowa, the son of Francis and Mary (Kane) Wisor. Jim graduated from Elvira High School and graduated with a Bachelor of Science in Animal Science in 1963 from Iowa State University.

Jim started his career as sales manager for agricultural companies before starting Wisor's Feed Barn in 1973, which was later incorporated into Wisor's Feed and Grain in Low Moor and Teeds Grove, Iowa.
