Lois 'Jean' LePrevost, 79 of Clinton passed away peacefully at her home, surrounded by family on Tuesday, September 22, 2020.

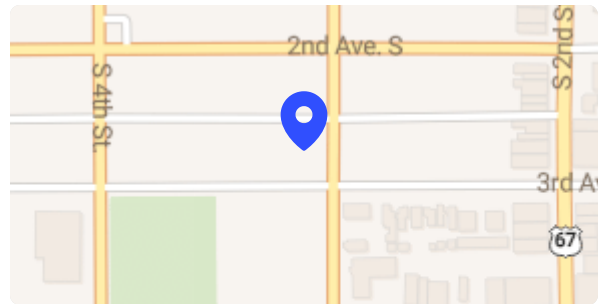

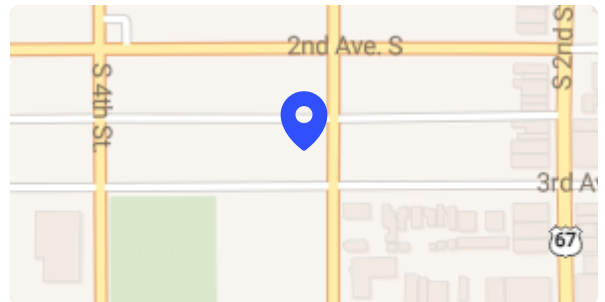
