Richard (Rich) J. Orman, 70, of Camanche passed away Monday, November 23, 2020 at CGH Medical Center - Sterling.

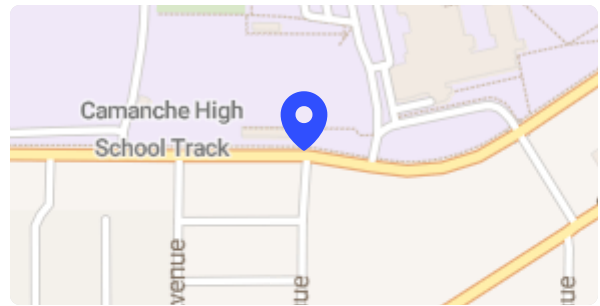

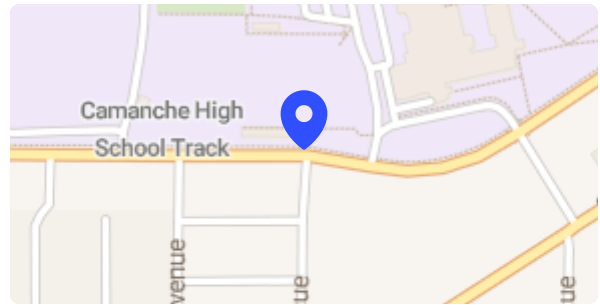

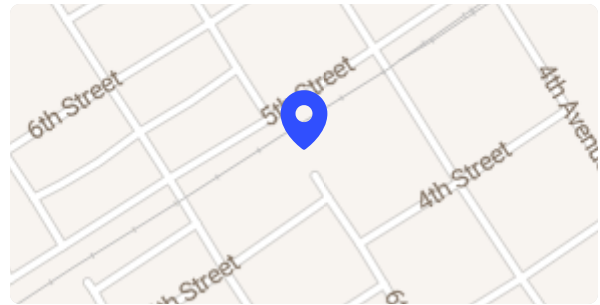
