Memorials can be made to the Arch or First United Methodist Church.

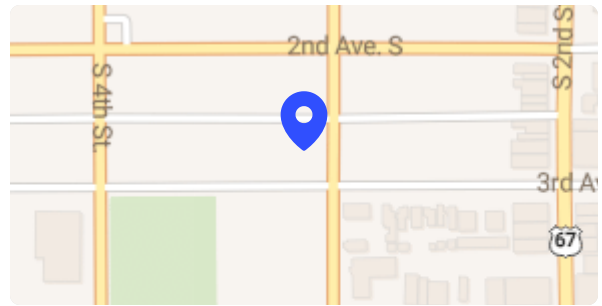

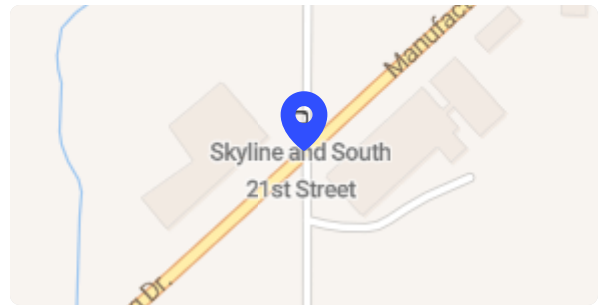
