Memorials can be made to Calvary Baptist Church – Clinton or First Baptist Church – Camanche.



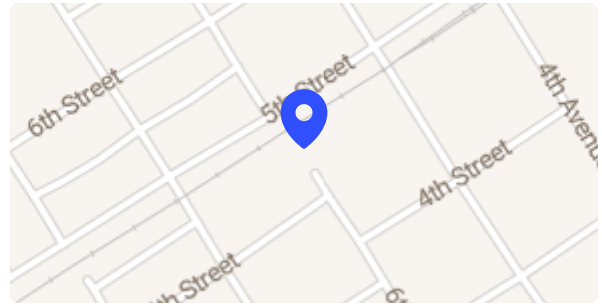

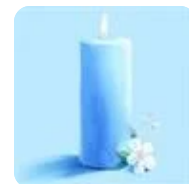

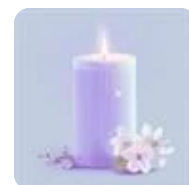
