**L**aFern A. Heath, 90, of Clinton, Iowa, died Friday, September 14, 2012 at the University of Iowa Hospital, Iowa City. Services will be 1 PM, Tuesday, September 18, 2012 at the Clinton Chapel Snell-Zornig Funeral Home & Crematory. Visitation will be Tuesday from 11 AM until the service hour at the funeral home. Burial will be in the Clinton Lawn Cemetery. Pallbearers will be Ben Heath, Tim Heath, Larry Andersen, Randy Andersen, Neal Andersen and Brad Thomas. LaFern was born August 20, 1922 in Deep Creek Township, Clinton County, the daughter of Arthur and Emma (Lorenzen) Rohweder.
