**R**uby Marie Mattke, 85, of Teeds Grove, Iowa died Tuesday, June 5, 2012 in Bellevue, Iowa. Services will be 10:00 am Saturday, June 9, 2012 at Faith Lutheran Church, Andover. Visitation will be from 4 to 8 pm Friday, June 8, 2012 at the Clinton Chapel Snell-Zornig Funeral Home & Crematory. Burial will be in the Andover Cemetery. Ruby was born March 15, 1927 in Teeds Grove, Iowa, the daughter of Edward and Henrietta (Huebner) Eggers.
