Wayne J. Paulline, 78, of Clinton, died Friday, February 24, 2012 at Mercy Living Center, North, Clinton. Funeral Services will be 1:00pm, Monday, February 27, 2012 at the Clinton Chapel Snell-Zornig Funeral Homes and Crematory. Burial will be in the Clinton Lawn Cemetery with military honors being conducted by the Clinton AMVETS Post #28.
