Visitation will be from 2-5:00 pm Sunday, April 18, 2010 at the Clinton Chapel Snell-Zornig Funeral Home and Crematory. Burial will be in Clinton Lawn Cemetery. Helen Anna Mohr was born on May 21, 1926 in Clinton, the daughter of Otto and Elsie (Hansen) Mohr. She was a graduate of Clinton High School and Clinton Community College. She married Robert F.
