Audrey D. Ewan, 91, of Springfield, IL, formerly of Clinton died Thursday, November 26, 2009 in Springfield. Cremation rites have been accorded. A memorial service will be held at 2:00 pm on Monday, December 28, 2009 at the First Baptist Church in Clinton. The Clinton Chapel Snell-Zornig Funeral Home and Crematory is in charge of the arrangements. Audrey Dixon Ewan was born on April 3, 1918 in Eureka, IL, the daughter of Lester and Irene (Mishler) Dixon. She was a 1936 graduate of Eureka High School, and attended Eureka College. She married Maurice A. Ewan on February 6, 1937 in Eureka; he died on February 9, 2005. She had been employed with Medical Associates in Clinton for 15 years until her retirement in 1980. She was a member of the First Baptist Church and American Baptist Women. She served as the church secretary, a Deacon and a Christian Education board member. She was a past president of the Horace Mann PTA.
