Lois Lorraine Sander, 80, of Clinton, died Thursday, January 17, 2008 at her home.

Funeral Services will be 11:00am, Saturday, January 19, 2008 at the Clinton Chapel Snell-Zornig Funeral Home and Crematory. Burial will be in the Clinton Lawn Cemetery. Serving as pallbearers will be Sheriff Rick Lincoln and members of the Clinton County Sheriff's Department.
