Mary Bertine Trimble, 88, of Clinton, died Monday, May 10, 2010 at the Alverno. Services will be 11:00 AM Saturday, May 22, 2010 at the Clinton Chapel Snell-Zornig Funeral Home & Crematory. Visitation will be Saturday from 10:00 AM until the service hour at the funeral home. Burial will be at St. Mary's Catholic Cemetery. Mary Bertine Trimble was born to Leo and Marie (Hand) Ryan on January 2, 1922, Welton, Iowa. Bertine is predeceased by her husband, Robert (Bob), son, Richard (Rick), her parents, her sister, Catherine Garrity, and several brothers-in-law and sisters-in-law.
