**M**ildred F. Colehour, 97, of Clinton died Saturday, March 20, 2010 at Mercy Living Center North. Memorial Services will be held 11:00 AM Saturday, March 27, 2010 at the Clinton Chapel Snell-Zornig Funeral Home & Crematory. Mildred was born September 27, 1912 in Clinton, Iowa the daughter of Arthur and Mary Clause Fink. She married Harry Clayman in Norfolk, Virginia on December 31, 1940.
