# Petronela Klimczyk

FEB 18, 1928 - MAR 30, 2008

**P**etronela "Nela" Klimczyk loving, caring, faith-filled wife and mother, died peacefully in the Lord on Sunday, March 30, 2008 at 9:30 pm at the Alverno Nursing Home, Clinton.

Nela was born on February 18, 1928 in Lysiec, Poland, the daughter of Wladyslaw and Anna (Debald) Jablonski. She married John F. Klimczyk on May 11, 1946 in Guttngen, Germany; he later died January 2, 1998 in Clinton.

She worked as a nursing technician at Mercy Hospital from 1953 until 1991. She will be missed by many friends, co-workers, acquaintances, and the staff and residents of the Alverno. Her gracious smile, sincere kindness and generosity will be long remembered and appreciated.
