Willis J. Lueders, 76, of Clinton, died Thursday, March 11, 2010 at his home. Funeral Services will be 1:00pm, Monday, March 15, 2010 at the Clinton Chapel Snell-Zornig Funeral Homes and Crematory with Pastor Christine Minor-Heilig officiating. Burial will be in the Clinton Lawn Cemetery with military honors being conducted by the Clinton AMVETS.
