Susan M. Kennedy (Willits), 96, of Clinton has passed on. She died on Sunday, December 28, 2008 at the Alverno Health Care Facility in Clinton, where she has lived happily among friends for the past few years. Mass of the Christian Burial will be 11:00 A.M. on Wednesday, December 31, 2008 at Prince of Peace Parish Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Clinton with Father Tom Hennen celebrating. She will be buried in Calvary Hill Cemetery, Fulton, IL, beside her beloved husband Francis. Visitation will be at the church one hour prior to mass at 10:00 A.M. The Clinton Chapel Snell-Zornig Funeral Home and Crematory is in charge of the arrangements. Susan Mary Willits was born on April 6th, 1912 in Clinton, IA, to Clyde and Clara (Young) Willits.
