Wayne Allen Turney, 73, of Clinton, Iowa, died Thursday, May 10, 2012 at his home. Funeral services will be held, Monday, May 14, 2012 at 10:30am at First United Methodist Church, 7th Avenue South and 3rd Street, Clinton. Visitation will be Sunday, May 13, 2012 from 3 to 7pm, at the church. The Clinton Chapel Snell-Zornig Funeral Home & Crematory assisted the family with arrangements. Burial will be in the Clinton Lawn Cemetery, where Military honors will be conducted. Wayne was born June 11, 1938 in Clinton, Iowa, the son of Blaine T. and Hazel A. (Wilden) Turney. He was a 1956 graduate of Clinton High School. Wayne married Darlene Warning on October 8, 1977 in Tinley Park, IL. Wayne proudly served four years in the United States Navy, and was a Viet Nam Veteran serving on the USS Guide MSO-447.
