**N**orma Belle Mortensen, 84, a long-time resident of Clinton, passed away in her home Wednesday evening, October 29, 2008. She died peacefully, as is deserved by all good people like her. Family and friends of Norma are invited to attend funeral services, which will be held at 10:30 AM on Monday, November 3, 2008 at the Clinton Chapel Snell-Zornig Funeral Home and Crematory.
