Dorothy V. King, 88, of Clinton, died Thursday, February 26, 2009 at the Clarissa C. Cook Hospice House, Bettendorf, Iowa. Mass of the Christian Burial will be 10:30am, Monday, March 2, 2009 at Prince of Peace Parish St. Mary's Catholic Church. Burial will be in the St. Mary's Catholic Cemetery.
