Theresa J. Hynous, 47, of rural Camanche, died Thursday, May 28, 2009 in Camanche. A Memorial Visitation will be held, Monday, June 1, 2009 from 4:00-7:00pm at the Camanche Chapel Snell-Zornig Funeral Home and Crematory. Theresa Jean Henle was born on September 5, 1961 in Clinton, Iowa, the daughter of Joseph and Patricia (Simmert) Henle. She married Gene Hynous on May 26, 1981 in Clinton. Theresa was a 1980 graduate of Clinton High School. Theresa was currently employed at Camanche Middle School where enjoyed serving the kids in the cafeteria. She was also formerly worked at Jane Lamb and Mercy Hospitals and DM Services. Theresa liked everyone and never spoke ill of anyone. She was a loving and devoted mother and wife.
