1930 - 2009 Robert H. Mohr, 78, of Clinton, IA, died Thursday, February 5, 2009 at his home in Clinton, IA. Visitation will be at the Clinton Chapel Snell-Zornig Funeral Home & Crematory on Sunday, February 8, 2009 from 2:00 PM to 6:00 PM, where a 2PM vigil service will be conducted. Additional visitation will be from 9:30AM until the service hour Monday at the church. Burial will be in St. Irenaeus Cemetery, where military honors will be conducted.
